WAYLAND, MA – Department of Public Works – The Wayland Water Division is issuing the attached Water Supply Status Report to inform Wayland Water customers of the current water supply conditions.

Effective immediately, The Water Division is upgrading its level of Nonessential Outdoor Water Use Restrictions to: Voluntary Odd/Even Restricted Use

- **Underground sprinklers & above ground sprinklers attached to hoses:** *Underground and above ground sprinkler use is allowed on an Odd/Even basis. Watering may begin at 12:00am and continue until 9:00am, and again from 5:00pm to 12:00pm. Odd number houses may water on odd number days, even numbered houses on even days*
- **Handheld Hose:** *Handheld hose watering is permitted anytime.*

Due to low water flows on the Concord River at USGS Streamflow Gauge #01099500 (99.5 cubic feet per second as of 11:45am on 9/18/19). The Wayland Water Division must institute Nonessential Outdoor Water Use Restrictions based on the Wayland Water Management Act Permit. This restriction will remain in place until the Streamflow increases to 156 cubic feet per second for 7 consecutive days or September 30th, whichever comes first.

This restriction is not based on an operational issue and is purely based on Streamflow restrictions written into Wayland's Water Management Act Permit.
