WayCAM's Successes:

- Studio HD Upgrades: WayCAM continues to bring new technology to our community by upgrading our equipment each year. This year we've upgraded the following sites. In the Town building we've upgraded several of our systems to HD; the BOS room, the SC room and the Senior Center room. In our studio we've upgraded the studio switcher, studio lights, playback system, our On-Demand and the monitoring cameras to HD; including the roof top camera. In the School Field House we've upgraded the studio to HD for sporting events and Town Meeting. We've also added a live feed to broadcast live events from the Press Box located in the Football Field.
- <u>Community Outreach</u>: WayCAM continue to teach its community Access classes this year. We gained new programs and new volunteers with these classes. Our newest programs are, "News Not Noise" and "The Bergeron Brief".
- <u>High School Classes</u>: The High School classes, TV Production I, II, and Honors Script to Screen are collaborations between the HS Media Department and the Theater Department. This year we entered 3 of our movies into several International Awards. I'm please to say that two of our films won the "Silver Award" from the Communicator Awards. The Winners were "Spectacle," by Parker Bryant and "Animals" by Jason Mai. WayCAM congratulates both of you. WayCAM's student volunteers crewed 124 programs, filling 240 crew positions, so great job to them!
- WayCAM Scholarships: We continue to fund our scholarship program with WayCAM membership money and income from DVD duplication fees. WayCAM double the awarded this year to \$1,000.00. WayCAM also gave the scholarship to two deserving graduating seniors, Declan Nolan and Brad Varnum. Congratulations to both winners of the 2014 WayCAM scholarships.
- Youth Programs: WayCAM continues to strengthen relationships with school age students through programs such as: Pegasus Summer Program, Before/ After School Extension (BASE), *Pelham Island Productions, the Girl & Boys Scouts, and WayCo Amateur Sports Development, Inc.
- Community Frequent Visitors to WayCAM Website: Our continually updated website has been a huge success with the community of Wayland. We are averaging 7,605 monthly visits, this figure increased by 1,543 per month.
- New Record for PEG Programs: WayCAM again breaks it's old record of **50** programs a month to it's new recording of **54** programs a month. The total PEG programs taped this year were **657** programs. We had a total of **888** production hours this year.
- New Record for On-Demand Programs: WayCAM had a huge increase in viewership on our brand new On-Demand this year. We had 48,433 loads this year; the previous year we only had 8,967 loads. That was a over 39,000 increase. Please continue to watch all our programs On-Demand from your computer at your convenience. Just go to our website and check them out.
