WAYLAND, MA – Department of Public Works – The Wayland Water Division is issuing this notice to inform Wayland Water customers of the current water supply conditions and this subsequent Water Ban implementation.

Effective immediately, The Water Division is upgrading its level of Nonessential Outdoor Water Use Restrictions to: Mandatory Restricted Use

- <u>Underground sprinklers & above ground sprinklers attached to hoses:</u> Underground and above ground sprinkler use is allowed on Tuesdays and Thursdays. Watering may begin at 12:00am and continue until 9:00am, and again from 5:00pm to 11:59pm.
- <u>Handheld Hose</u>: Handheld hose watering is permitted anytime.

Due to low water flows on the Concord River at USGS Streamflow Gauge #01099500 (415 cubic feet per second on 5-30-2020). The Wayland Water Division must institute Nonessential Outdoor Water Use Restrictions based on the Wayland Water Management Act Permit. This restriction will remain in place until the Streamflow increases to 427 cubic feet per second for 7 consecutive days in May and June.

This restriction is not based on an operational issue and is purely based on Streamflow restrictions written into Wayland's Water Management Act Permit.
