FINCOM ARTICLE

- 1. Moderator appoints FinCom
- 2. Budget prepared by Board of Selectmen
- 3. FinCom independently reviews budget

SPENDING IS EXCESSIVE

- Moody's rates Wayland bonds <u>Aaa</u> but notes: "town's financial position is lower than Aaa median."
- 4/29/19 FinCom: budget increases should be 3.1%
- 2/13/20 FinCom Guideline: 3.3% (\$2.7M) increase
 Currently: 4.5% (\$3.7M) increase

Inflation: 2.5% past 12 months.

TAXPAYER BURDENS

- Total property taxes up 30% over past 10 years.
- US inflation up 19% in same time period.
- Unsustainable Town spending leads to unsustainable tax increases

FINDINGS OF THE COLLINS CENTER

 Town Legislature (Town Meeting) needs help dealing with the budget.

That help must come from an independent FinCom.

 Moderator-appointed FinCom provides that independence.

WHAT DO OTHER TOWNS DO?

- Wayland has 13 peer communities.
- In 10/13 = 77% Moderator appoints.
- In NONE Selectmen solely appoint FinCom.
- In ATFC survey 70/118 = 59% Moderator appoints.
- In ATFC survey 13/118 = 11% Selectmen appoint.
- In MMA survey 67/115 = 58% Moderator appoints.
- In MMA survey 13/115 = 11% Selectmen appoint.

WHY MODERATOR SHOULD APPOINT FINCOM

- Presently Selectmen appoint FinCom.
- Town Manager prepares budget for FinCom's review.
- All of the above are in Executive Branch.
- But Legislative Branch (Town Meeting) requires independent budget review.
- Not possible under present structure.
- Solution: Moderator appoints FinCom.
